The Texas Wildlife Association (TWA), established in 1985, is a collaborative organization dedicated to conserving and enhancing wildlife and habitat on private lands. The purpose of the Texas Big Game Awards (TBGA) is to promote awareness of wildlife management, highlight hunting's role in habitat conservation, and foster cooperation among stakeholders dedicated to preserving Texas' wildlife habitat for future generations.

TBGA is a free, certificate-based awards program that recognizes hunters who harvest quality big game animals in Texas, the land managers who sustain these animals, the significance of our hunting heritage, and the achievements of young and first-time hunters.

To safeguard this legacy, Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) and the Texas Wildlife Association (TWA) collaborated to establish TBGA. Today, TBGA remains a leader in promoting education and recognizing the importance of quality habitat and wildlife in Texas.

97% of the land in Texas is privately owned, encouraging landowners to actively manage their property for both quality wildlife and quality habitat will better ensure that all species remain an enduring part of our native ecosystem for generations to come. TBGA is not only important to land managers and hunters, it should also be of vital interest to everyone who has a stake in this multi-billion dollar-a-year industry in Texas, because "Hunting Equals Habitat."

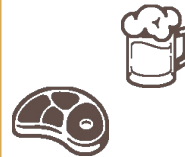
